


Kirtland's Warbler Wildlife Festival



2010 Young Artists Calendar Contest

Rules and Information

1. Entries must be original and deal with northern Michigan's unique jack pine forest ecosystem, the Kirtland's warbler or any other creatures that dwell in the jack pines.
2. Copyrighted cartoon characters, such as Smokey Bear and Woodsy Owl, cannot appear in entries.
3. Entries must be **HORIZONTALLY** drawn on a single **8.5-by-11-inch** sheet of white paper or poster board. Entries that are not horizontal will not be judged. 
4. Clearly record (please print) **ALL** student information in the box provided below and **TAPE TO THE REVERSE SIDE** (please, do not use staples, if possible) of each drawing.
5. Entries should be from individual students in grades K-8. No group drawings are allowed. **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT.** However, more than one entry from a class or school may be mailed in the same envelope.
6. Contest deadline is Monday, April 19, 2010. No entries will be accepted after 4 p.m. that day.
7. A panel of judges at Kirtland will judge each entry. Winners will be displayed at the Kirtland's Warbler Festival on the main campus of Kirtland Community College, near Roscommon, on May 15, 2010.
8. Entries become the property of Kirtland Community College and will not be returned.
9. The winning posters will be used in the new Kirtland's Warbler Festival Young Artists Calendar and may be posted on the Kirtland Web site at www.kirtland.edu. Students, teachers and schools will be identified on the calendar. Entries may also be used for other products and promotional material.
